PRESENTATION OF PROPOSED USE OF MUNICIPAL ROAD AID FUNDS AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE FUNDS (COAL SERVERANCE)

Mr. Ripberger reported that the anticipated funds for FY 09-10 are approximately \$70,000. These funds are based on census figures and taxes collected by the State on gasoline sales. They can only be used for street maintenance and repairs, not new construction. The funds will be used as follows: \$10,000 for general street maintenance and \$59,000 for contractor ordinary expenses.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mr. Ripberger commented that he is planning repair projects on the following streets: Foresthill Dr., Crescent Pointe Dr., Linden Hill, Rosewood, Anderson from Ireland Ave. to Buttermilk Pike, Harris Ave., Bromley/Crescent Springs Rd. at Emerald Springs, and short Amsterdam (between Anderson intersection and the Villa Hills line). This last project will be undertaken with approximately \$8,100 additional assistance from the County. Mr. Ripberger plans to build up the balance in the fund (presently approximately \$115,000) for emergencies.

There were no public comments from the floor.

ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Santangelo made a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing. Mr. Daugherty seconded and all agreed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:17 p.m.
