**ROAD REPAIRS ARE TAKING PLACE** - KDOT is in the process of replacing the crosswalk ramps with new ADA compliant ones, at the intersections along Buttermilk Pike. After this is complete they will begin resurfacing from the post office to Collins Rd. Weather permitting, this should be completed in the next several weeks. Street repairs by the City have been implemented as

well. Concrete sections and drainage sections are being repaired, due for completion by June 5. Asphalt repair and resurfacing should start around June 15, and take 5 to 7 days to complete.
