GREETINGS FROM MAYOR COLLETT

FINANCE UPDATE

The City's Finance Committee meets monthly to analyze the past month's financial performance as well as review the financial statements and condition of the City's finances.

The financial condition of the City remains solid. With our fiscal year coming to a close at 6/30/2010, the City's 10 month YTD revenues of \$2.1 million have adequately covered total expenses of \$1.85 million, and the City maintains strong re-

serves in both our Capital Improvements Fund and our General Fund. For the upcoming budget of fiscal year 7/1/2010-6/30/2011, the City is forecasting revenue of \$2.0 million (a slight decrease versus prior year) – made up mostly from Real Estate Property Taxes (35% of the revenue), Payroll Gross Receipts (30% of the revenue), and Insurance Premium Taxes (20% of the revenue). The balanced budget equally forecasts expenses at \$2.0 million (a slight decrease from the prior year) – made up mostly of Police protection services (40% of the expenses), Fire & Advanced Life Support (Ambulance) services (13% of the expenses), Public Works labor (8%), and expenses for the servicing of debt (loans for Park, City Building, street projects, etc.).
