CLEAN STREET POLICY

When the winter weather hits, you can count on the Public Service Department's "Clean Street Policy". To make streets as safe and clear as possible for those who live, work, and travel through Crescent Springs, Public Service crews work until all streets are plowed or salted to bare pavement. Major thoroughfares, bridges and hills receive priority, followed by residential streets.



Avoid shoveling snow into the street. Shoveling snow from your driveway into a street that has already been cleared may create safety hazards. Shoveling snow from your driveway into a street that has not been cleared will result in the snow being pushed back onto your driveway by the plow. Do not plow snow from a commercial lot into the roadway.

When conditions exist that require snow plowing or salting, please move vehicles off the street. This greatly assists service crews in their efforts to keep streets safe and clear. When a snow emergency is declared by the Mayor, (3 inches or more or icy conditions), it is mandatory that all vehicles be moved off the street. (City Ordinance 74.01) Failure to do so may result in a citation and the vehicle being towed. Tune to local radio or TV stations for snow emergency updates.

A sign will be at the entrance and a spot on the lot will be marked as to where to put the trees. Christmas trees may also be picked up curbside from December 27th to January 9th. Please REMOVE all lights & ornaments, and DO NOT BAG the trees as these items will cause damage to the chipper.

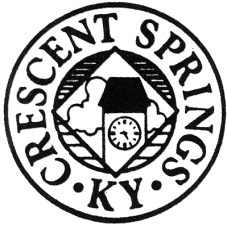

9/11 MEMORIAL NEWS

Have you visited the Crescent Community Park recently and noticed the base in place for the Northern Kentucky 9/11 Memorial? The Memorial will include renderings of the twin towers that once graced the New York City skyline. In the shape of a pentagon at the base, the Memorial will pay tribute to five groups deeply effected on that historic day: firefighters, police, the airline industry, civilians and the Pentagon. The centerpiece of the Memorial will be an I-Beam from Ground Zero that was procured by the Crescent Springs Villa Hills Fire/EMS. This site will be a history lesson to share with our children and grandchildren, and all we will have to do is take a walk to the park to share this experience.

The 9/11 Memorial Committee has been working for the past several months to turn the Memorial into a reality. Funding will be primarily through private contributions. This is where you come in as a resident of Crescent Springs.
