## POLICE NEWS

**School Opens:**

When driving near schools or bus stops, please be aware that school is back in session and children are present. Every year we have a child struck by a vehicle either near school property or on their way to school. Pay attention to the School Zone Speed Limits. If you are cited for speeding when the lights are flashing or during the time when the limits are in effect, the fine will be doubled.

**Thefts:**

We have seen a significant rise in the number of thefts from parked vehicles and homes. Use common sense; do not leave valuables in your car and make sure to lock your doors. No items should be left in your vehicle, especially GPS type devices which have become a favorite of thieves. Ladies, do not leave your purses in your vehicle or if grocery shopping, do not leave them in the cart.

**Burglary:**

We have also seen an increase in burglaries: thefts from homes. Leave lights on at night; thieves do not like to be seen. Keep all doors and windows locked. Most burglaries have been occurring in the daytime. If you see any suspicious activity, call 911. We would much rather respond and find nothing, than to find out later that a theft had occurred.
